



## **PETER A. PETRI**

Peter A. Petri is the Carl J. Shapiro Professor of International Finance at the Brandeis International Business School (IBS). He is also a Non-Resident Senior Fellow in the Brookings Institution's Foreign Policy Program and John L. Thornton China Center, and a Visiting Fellow at the Peterson Institute for International Economics. His research focuses on international trade, finance, investment and technological competition, primarily in the Asia Pacific region. He was founding Dean of IBS from 1994 to 2006 and Interim Dean from 2016 to 2018. He has held visiting appointments at the Asian Development Bank Institute, the Brookings Institution, Fudan University, Keio University, Peking University, the OECD and the World Bank, and consults for numerous international organizations and governments. He serves on the editorial boards of journals dedicated to Asia-Pacific research and is a member of the U.S. Asia Pacific Council. He received A.B. and Ph.D. degrees in economics from Harvard University.
